I am writing to announce that after much deliberation, I have accepted the position of Director of Teacher and Leadership Development for our school district. Please know that this was a very difficult decision to make, but it is the best decision at this time for me and my family.

Taking care of the school during this change is my priority. To that, I am pleased to announce that Mr. Jim Trimble, a widely-respected, and newly-retired elementary principal has agreed to serve until the new principal is hired.
